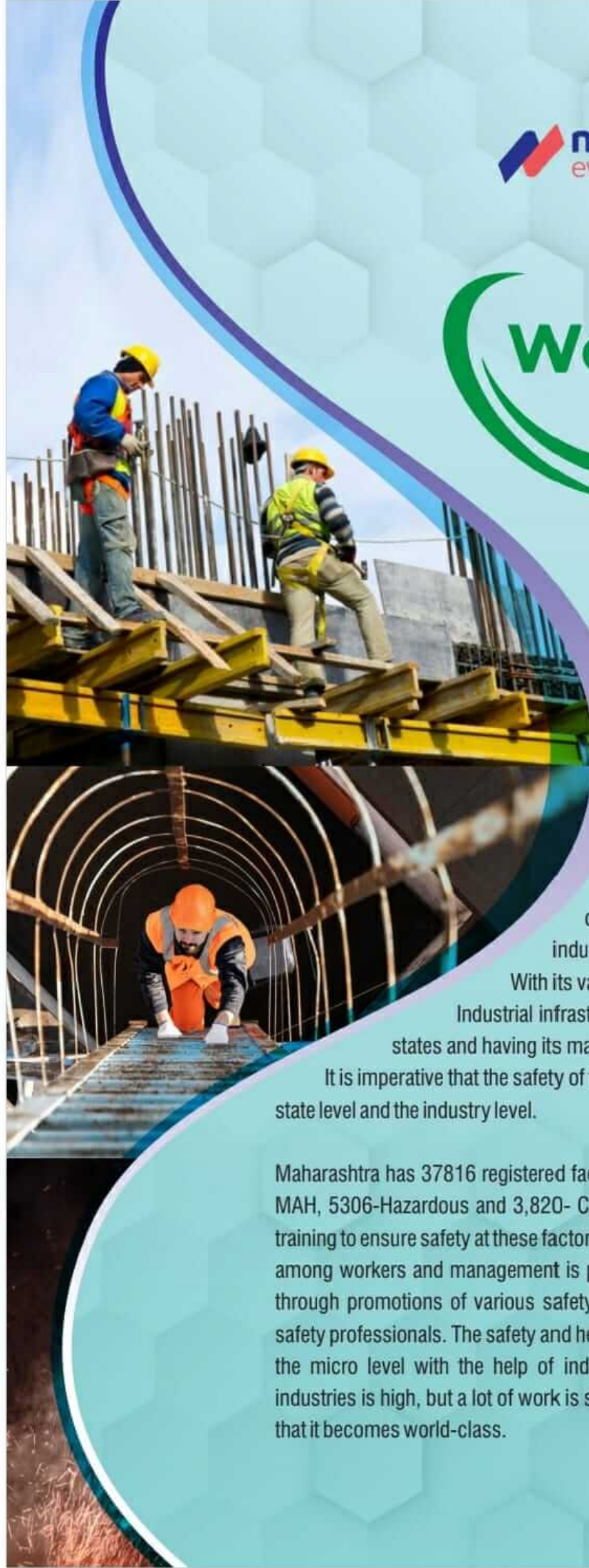
OVERVIEW
